Based on clinic needs...


- Reach out to multiple schools and student organizations

- Social media

Information to Consider for Volunteer Requests

- Estimate how many non-clinical and clinical volunteers are needed per vaccine event
 - What type(s) are needed?
- Estimate how much time per shift & how many shifts per vaccine event
- Estimate how many bilingual volunteers needed and specify which languages
- Whether there is an existing volunteer sign-up or application link
- What type of on-site supervision for clinical trainee volunteers
