## HIV Status and Risk Factors Among Underserved Populations in Los Angeles County

This presentation will provide demographic and risk data of individuals testing for HIV at the Charles R. Drew University store-front testing site in South Central Los Angeles. Data were collected from January 2013 to September 2015. Nearly 5,000 HIV tests were performed with 241 HIV positive test results, with a positivity rate of 4.5%, one of the highest in the county. Recommendations about how to better address the HIV epidemic among this subregion of Los Angeles will be shared.
