


SYSTEMIC RACISM AND UNEQUAL RISK OF HIV INFECTION

"Research has shown that even when risk factors are equal or less, sexually active minority youth face a higher risk of HIV and STIs."

The people in their "pool" of sexual partners are more likely to be HIV positive or have an STI, raising the odds of infection. But why?
