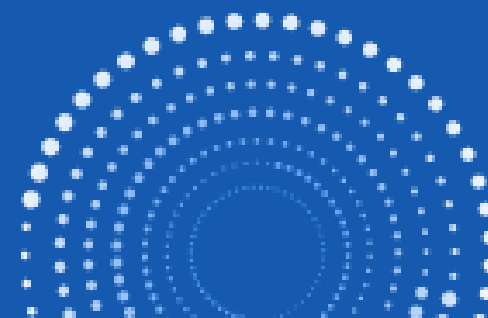

**Purpose:** To solicit applications for Resource-Related Research Projects, including one Coordination, Consultation, and Data Management Center (CCDMC) and multiple Regional Consultation Hubs (RCHs), that will support ongoing implementation science research funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to address the goals of the EHE initiative

## **Key goals:**

- Synthesize findings across the NIH EHE research portfolio
- Accelerate dissemination of findings and best practices to federal and local implementing partners

**Standalone funding opportunity not connected to the CFARs/ARCs**

**Primary focus/priority will be on projects that receive direct EHE funding. However, we anticipate could potentially provide resources and networking opportunities for EHE-related projects**
