- Non-Clinical Community Based Organization
- Limited medical infrastructure (Protocols, EHR, etc.)
- Low uptake of PrEP among priority populations




How can a CBO provide PrEP services?

- Partner with a provider that provides
 - Uses video PrEP appointments
- Contract with an at home Testing Laboratory
 - Provides HIV, STI and Kidney Function Screening
- Partner with a pharmacy that can mail prescriptions






REACH LA Telehealth 2020 Timeline

- Develop strong partnerships with in-person PrEP Providers
- Establish a strong remote and internal linkage to care program
- Increase treatment referral network for nonlocal clients
- Invest in a E.H.R. program that works for you
- Request training for motivational interview and other rapport building skills
- Seek funding for inhouse STI Treatment
