

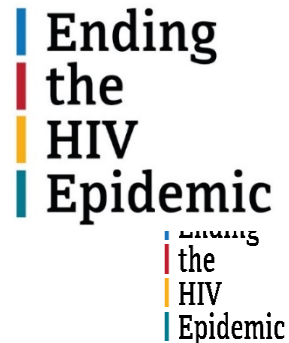

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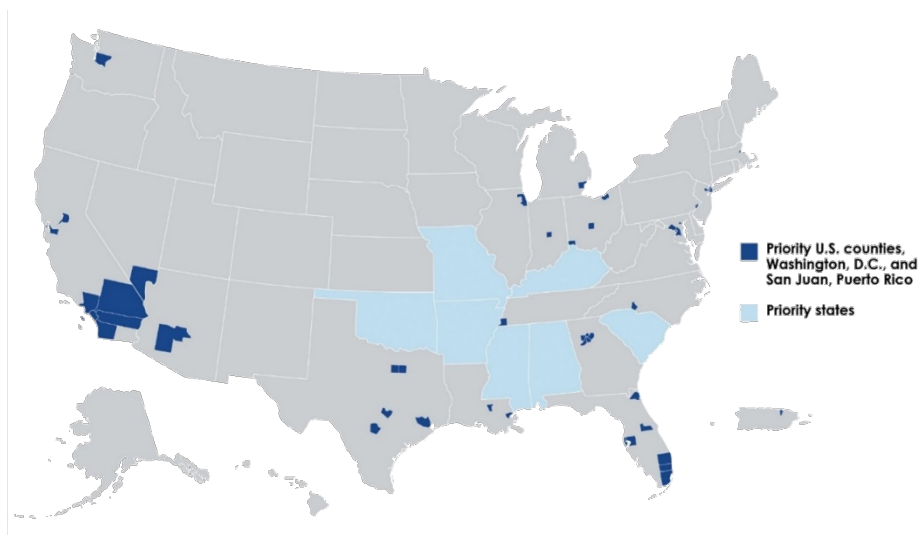

## Pillars of EHE

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**Diagnose** all people with HIV as early as possible.



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**Treat** people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.



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**Prevent** new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).



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**Respond** early to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.
