


HIV Prevention and New Era





Coming April 2017

Transgender Women

41% attempted suicide

19% report being refused medical care because of their gender non-conforming status

50% of the sample reported having to teach their medical providers about transgender care.

Many fear for their safety because of anti TG violence

49x more likely to have HIV than other adults

- Social and economic marginalization
- High unemployment/sex work
- Limited health care access
- Lack of family support
