"Social immiseration, changing drug use patterns and HIV risk among community-recruited people who inject drugs in Denver, Colorado and Los Angeles, and San Francisco California."

HIV risk among people who inject drugs have been successfully reduced by harm reduction strategies and improved access to health care. However, material conditions in this population and changing drug use patterns may have influenced HIV risk factors. This presentation will examine material conditions, drug use patterns, and HIV risk among people who inject drugs in 3 cities between 2016 and 2022.
